The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the above-referenced document pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508) and Section 309 of the Clean Air Act. EPA reviewed the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) and provided comments to the Forest Service (FS) on September 21, 2007. We rated the DEIS as EC-2, *Environmental Concerns, Insufficient Information* and recommended that the U.S. International Boundary and Water Commission (IBWC): 1) clarify the differences between the No Build and Build Alternatives and 2) describe potential actions associated with the Build Alternatives and anticipated environmental consequences. Our concerns have been addressed in the Final EIS (FEIS) and we look forward to reviewing future documents related to site-specific actions.
