Approved indirect cost rate agreements include an attachment that identifies a list of those cost that are included in the "pool" used to derive the indirect cost rate (eg, Attachment 2—CY 2010 Indirect Cost Pool and Rate Computation). This list of costs may include salaries of certain positions that are held within the organization (eg, Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Secretary to the CEO, Receptionist,

Being identified on this list means that these individuals' salaries are being paid using money that have been recouped from funding sources, including EPA grants, being charged indirect cost (ie, budget has money under the indirect cost category). Therefore, for those EPA grants containing indirect cost in the approved budget, part of money the organization gets from EPA goes to pay for salaries of those individuals on the list. Compensation is to be reported in FSRS.gov if it falls within the 5 most highly compensated.
