
TSCA - Disclosure of Known Lead-Based Paint and /or Based-Paint Hazards Upon Lease of Residential Property

January 28, 2010

- The seller or lessor shall provide the purchaser or lessee with an EPA-approved lead hazard information pamphlet
- Protect Your Family From Lead in Your Home (EPA #747-K-94-001) or an equivalent pamphlet that has been approved for use in that State by EPA





Disclosure requirements for lessors

- The lessor shall disclose to the lessee the presence of any known lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards in the target housing being sold or leased
- The lessor shall also disclose any additional information available concerning the known lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards
 - Such as the basis for the determination that lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards exist
 - The location of the lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards
 - The condition of the painted surfaces

Disclosure of Information on Lead-Based Paint and/or Lead-Based Paint Hazards

Lead Warning Statement

Hausing built before 1978 may contain lead-based point. Lead from paint, paint chips, and dusi can pose health hazards if not managed property. Lead exposure is especially harmful to young children and pregnant women. Before renting pre-1978 housing, lessors must disclose the presence of known lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards in the dwelling. Lessees must also receive a federally approved pamphlet on lead polsoning prevention.

Lessor's Disclosure

(a) Presence of lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards (check (i) or (ii) below);

- Lessor has no knowledge of lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards in the housing.
- (b) Records and reports available to the lessor (check (i) or (ii) below):
 - Lessor has provided the lessee with all available records and reports pertaining to lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards in the housing (list documents below).
 - (II) Lessor has no reports or records pertaining to lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards in the housing.

- Each contract to lease, as an attachment or within the contract, the following elements
 - A Lead Warning Statement
 - A statement by the lessor disclosing the presence of known lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards in the target housing being leased

or indicating no knowledge of the presence of lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards

The lessor shall also disclose any additional information available as the:

Basis for the determination The location The condition of the painted surfaces

- A list of any records or reports available to the lessor. If no such records or reports are available, the lessor shall so indicate
- A statement by the lessee affirming receipt of all the information
- The signatures of the lessors, agents, and lessees, certifying to the accuracy of their statements, to the best of their knowledge, along with the dates of signature

Retention of Certification and Acknowledgment Information

The lessor, and any agent, shall retain a copy of the completed attachment or lease contract for no less than 3 years
