We appreciate the opportunity to review the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (FSEIS) for the Santa Ana River Interceptor (SARI) Line Protection/Relocation and the Corps' response to our April 28, 2008 comments on the Draft Supplemental EIS (DSEIS). The EPA previously rated the DSEIS EC-2, "Environmental Concerns - Insufficient Information", due to our concerns with the proposed alignment of the preferred Alternative OC 3B, Orange County Relocate to the South, "Shallow Alternative", and potential impacts to water quality and waters of the United States associated with the Santa Ana River. The Corps has provided sufficient information in the FSEIS and the response to comments to address our concerns.
