

Dear Mr. Furlan:

I am in receipt of your letter dated March 18, 2011 (copy enclosed) requesting additional information and to voluntarily begin monitoring for additional parameters not currently required in the NPDES Permit.

Please correct your records as the Allegheny Valley Joint Sewage Authority POTW does not accept wastewater from gas drilling Marcellus shale operations. Apparently the Authority is on a PA DEP list of treatment facilities that accept this type of waste. An activated sludge treatment facility is not designed to treat or remove total dissolved solids or chlorides at levels associated with drilling fluids found in the Marcellus shale waste. Therefore, we do not accept this type of waste.

The Authority has an established domestic waste disposal program. We do accept waste from outside sources which includes septic tanks and a small amount of gas drilling waste from shallow wells. As you know, shallow wells do not have the high level of contamination associated with Marcellus drilling fluids.

For your information, as a result of the controversial issues in the treatment of drilling fluids, the Authority has decided to discontinue the treatment of brines and shallow drilling fluids.

The Pittsburgh PA DEP Regional Office is currently reviewing the Authority's renewal application for the NPDES Permit.
