- > Communicate and negotiate in a civil and respectful manner.

- > Stretch your mind... feel free to propose any creative, workable solution you think might help in resolving this dispute. "Mistakes" are the seeds of brilliance.
- > Be mindful of how important it is to your peers that you reach a durable resolution.
- > Remember that your contribution to this agenda will be recognized, honored and appreciated by manufacturers and consumers for a very long time.
