What are Brownfields?

- Once-productive areas that are abandoned; some are contaminated
- Communities, private and public lenders, investors, and developers fear environmental liability and are more attracted to "greenfields"
- ▶ The result is blighted properties brownfields
- ▶ U.S. General Accountability Office (GAO) estimates more than 450,000 brownfields across the country
- Brownfields program is a *community* initiated program

Lawrence, Massachusetts – Brownfields to Parks

- Lawrence was one of the first planned industrial cities, founded in the 1840s on the Merrimack River
- Textile based economy located along the Merrimack and Spicket Rivers
- Decline in Textile industry in 1970s led to vacant properties
- ▶ 1996 the City was awarded its first assessment grant – 2004 first EWD&JT grant



Lawrence, Massachusetts -A Brownfield Urban Water Example

- The City of Lawrence has partnered with Groundwork Lawrence and YouthBuild
- EPA funds Groundwork USA, part of the Rivers and Trails program of the National Park Service, one of our many active partners
- 700 volunteers removed 17 tons of trash and 200 tires from the Spicket River.



Lawrence, Massachusetts -Brownfields to Urban Agriculture

- The City works with Ground Work Lawrence and other partners to turn vacant lots into gardens to address childhood obesity
- They are working with Harvard University Medical School staff to study the public health impacts
- The Massachusetts Attorney General recently awarded the City a grant to extend police work that includes building gardens to reduce gang violence
