This is to inform you that the subject permit was issued by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX (EPA) for a period of five (5) years beginning November 6, 2006. The permit, which is enclosed, shall become effective forty (40) days after the date of permit issuance. Prior to the effective date of the permit, any person who filed comments on the draft permit may petition the Environmental Appeals Board to review any condition of the permit decision. You can review the procedural requirements of the UIC permit appeal process at 40 C.F.R. Section 124.19. For your information, 40 C.F.R. The comment period for the subject permit closed on July 19, 2006. EPA's Ground Water Office received 15 comments on the draft permit during the public comment period.
