Enclosed is the fourth of four sets of documents responsive to your Freedom of Information Act request, HQ-FOI-01268-12. This final release consists of emails received or sent through former Administrator Lisa P. Jackson's secondary account that include at least one of the words specified in your request.

As you are aware, Administrator Jackson used a secondary email account to conduct EPA business. This account was established for practical purposes, and its contents are maintained in accordance with federal recordkeeping guidelines and are searched in response to all FOIA, discovery and other legally required information requests.

Consistent with past practice, the name on this account had been redacted in the first release and marked *Administrator* to preserve the utility of the email account and to clearly identify the records as being to or from the Administrator. As we did in our second release to you in February and the third release in March, we no longer redact the name on the account because Administrator Jackson's departure from the agency has obviated the need to protect her secondary account from an impractical volume of email.

This correspondence marks the agency's final response to your FOIA request. Please know that we consider it a privilege to serve you and all of the American people as we fulfill our commitment to transparency and accountability and our mission to protect public health and the environment.
